The meeting was called to order at 1pm.

Acting ECE Head William Sanders presented the [charge to the Curriculum committee](#) for the academic year.

The items in the charge were discussed.

The first item is to “obtain campus approval for and complete implementation of new Computer Engineering Curriculum.” The CC decided to appoint a committee of three ECE faculty members to prepare the draft proposal: Steve Lumetta (chair), Sayan Mitra, and Nitin Vaidya.

The second item is to “complete transition from ECE 190/290 to ECE 120/220.” It was noted that this semester’s offering of ECE 198JL is the precursor to ECE 120, and ECE 198KL is the precursor to ECE 220. ECE 190 will no longer be offered, effective next spring. While ECE 198KL is a four hour course, it is envisioned that ECE 220 will be a three hour course. Vlad (Volodymyr) Kindratenko is currently preparing the proposals for ECE 120 and ECE 220.

In addition to the charges in the letter, Erhan suggested the committee address the topic of scientific computing for students in the EE curriculum. It was noted by Paris that David Forsyth in CS is working on a sophomore level course in that direction.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:50 PM.
