The objections to the CompE proposal were carefully made and there was little response in its defense. It was suggested that room could be made in the CompE curriculum to reintroduce 329 and 340 by scaling back the hours of 110 and 190. It was also noted that the CompE portion of the 28 required hours of tech electives be specified. Also the advanced core in the CompE curriculum should be detailed on-line during the two-week discussion period.
