The meeting was called to order at 2:12 PM.

Minutes of Nov. 28, 2012 were approved.

The request to merge ECE465 and a separate lab course ECE466 into a new combined course to be called ECE465 with the appropriate adjustment of credit hours was approved subject to the correction of a spelling error.

The Alumni Survey previously distributed by e-mail was discussed. The following recurring themes in the responses were noted:

- ▲ The addition of business related career paths.
- A Our department has a reputation for producing employees with superb technical backgrounds.
- ▲ There should be an emphasis on breadth of curriculum so as to make employees as flexible as possible.
- A There should be greater emphasis placed on the development of communication skills

It was noted that these themes are in agreement with ABET goals. This prompted a reminder that next semester all course directors will have to submit their evaluations for the ABET report.

The CompE revised curriculum proposal was reviewed. It will be presented to the ECE faculty for approval early in the Sp. '13 term. In preparation for this meeting committee members are free to discuss the matter with colleagues informally. Also there will be meetings of interested technical area committees with the CompE area committee prior to the faculty meeting.

ECE has suffered a computer security breach. The unknown perpetrator is continuing the attacks and the investigation is ongoing. The faculty have been advised of this problem which has implications for final exams and other class assignments.

This is the final meeting of the curriculum committee for the Fall '12 term.
