ECE412 is presently dormant due to the need for upgrading the lab equipment. Therefore, the matter of the new CS233 as a prerequisite is moot.

Lumetta was not able to attend to present a draft proposal of the CompE curriculum. It should be available at the next meeting. In the meanwhile the discussion continued on several key issues.

- ▲ How do we insure breadth in the CompE curriculum, particularly electromagnetics and solid state physics? Five of our peer institutions use options from an m of n list for advanced core courses.
- Are we using the same criteria for breadth in the EE and CompE programs?
- EEs take 190 and 290 so shouldn't CompE's take 329 and 340?
- EEs don't have requirements for control and scientific computing.
- The breadth requirements for CompEs could be met with a new course covering EM, solid state physics, digital signal processing, control and communications.
- ▲ Alternatively Phys 213 and 214 could be modified to meet our needs. They are presently not adequate for this purpose. We still need to review the 214 syllabus.
- There could be two alternative tracks in CompE, one concentrating on processor design the other on computing systems.
- ▲ We need to maintain coherence in our ECE curriculum. We could have a single program with different concentrations, perhaps more than just the two present ones.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 PM.
