Minutes of the Curriculum Committee April 13, 2004

- 1) Members present: Tangu Basar, Jennifer Bernhard, Donna Brown, Seth Hutchinson, Wen-Mei Hwu, Daniel Liberzon, Tom Overbye, Sanjay Patel, Dilip Sarwate, Naresh Shanbhag.
- 2) The minutes of March 30, 2004 meeting were approved.
- 3) The committee voted in favor of retaining ECE 313 as a 300 level course, i.e., revert back the new ECE 413 into ECE 313, a course meant to be taken in the junior year. It should be recalled that this is a *required* course under the new EE and CompE curricula.
- 4) After further debates and discussions about the Technical Electives rules the committee voted in favor of the following changes concerning Technical Electives and Advanced ECE Electives in the EE curriculum:

"TECHNICAL ELECTIVES:

35 hrs to be selected from a departmentally approved Technical Electives List (see item 5 below) including

- a) A minimum of 6 hrs of non-ECE courses,
- b) A minimum of 22 hrs of ECE courses with at least:
 - (i) 2 hrs of labs,
 - (ii) 3 of the following 5:
 - ECE 390 or CS 225(225)
 - ECE 410
 - ECE 430
 - ECE 442/443
 - ECE 450"

- 5) The following is the current version of ``departmentally approved Technical Electives List''; new course numbers are shown in parenthesis. The list is a merger of the previously used Basic Science Electives, Engineering Science Electives, and Technical Electives lists. One of the next tasks of the Curriculum Committee will be to re-examine and update this list to be used in conjunction with the revised technical electives rule.
